



Terms and Conditions

STALLION ENROLLMENT – Stallions enrolling for the first time will pay an initial fee of \$2,500. The \$2,500 is divided as follows: \$1,250 for the first annual fee and \$1,250 for prepaid pass out fee. For stallions renewing enrollments, the fee is \$1,250 (postmarked by February 1). After February 1, the renewal fee is \$2,250, which includes a \$1,000 late charge. In the event of death, sale, or the stallion owner electing to no longer participate in the program, the stallion's prepaid pass out fee will be drawn on in order for the foals of the stallion's last breeding year to be eligible.

The annual stallion fee is allocated in the following way: 70% is purse money for the current year's show and 30% is administrative expense (advertising, promotional materials, office staff, postage, etc.).

The owner/agent or nominator of the stallion agrees to provide NRBC promotional information to each mare owner breeding to the stallion. He or she also agrees to mail NRBC Foal Enrollment Forms to the owner of each live foal at the time the Breeders Certificate is provided. The promotional material and forms are provided by the NRBC and may also be found on the NRBC Web Site www.nrbc.com.

FOAL ENROLLMENT — To be eligible for the four-, five- and six-year-old National Reining Breeders Classic, the foal must be sired by a subscribed NRBC stallion. Owner/agent must complete the enrollment form (attach a copy of the registration papers, if available at this time), enclose a **one time payment for \$200 per foal**, postmarked by September 15, of the foal's **birth year**, or \$250 if postmarked by December 31, of the foal's birth year. Enrollment forms missing any pertinent information will be held. The owner/agent will be notified by phone, fax, or by mail to complete the enrollment process.

Late enrollment of foals is as follows:

\$2,500 - yearlings \$7,500 - 2-year-olds \$10,000 - 3-year-olds and older

Yearlings that were not enrolled as weanlings may late enroll and pay all at once or make the following payments: 2 payments of \$1,250 each due by December 31, of their yearling year and December 31 of their 2 -year-old year. Two-year-olds that were not enrolled as weanlings or yearlings may late enroll and pay all at once or make the following payments: 3 payments of \$2,500 – the first due December 31 of the 2-year-old year; the second due December 31 of the 3 -year-old year; and the third due March 1 of the four-year-old year. The third and last payment must be received prior to the entry deadline for the Breeders Classic.

Three-year-olds that were not enrolled as weanlings, yearlings, or 2 -year-olds may late enroll and may pay all at once or make the following payments: 2 payments of \$5,000, the first is due by December 31 of their 3 -year-old year and the second is due by March 1, of their 4-year-old year. Final payment must be received prior to the entry deadline for the Breeders Classic that the horse is to compete in.

Foal enrollment is not dependent upon the stallion's continued enrollment. Contact NRBC office for current listing of subscribed stallions or visit our web site www.nrbc.com.

All named foals (providing NRBC has a copy of the foal's registration papers or National DNA Registry certificate) will receive a Breeders Classic Certificate when enrolled. Those foals with names pending will receive their certificate when the NRBC office receives a copy of the registration papers. Duplicate certificates will be charged a fee of \$10. The fee must be paid before the duplicate certificate will be sent.

INELIGIBILITY – Failure to pay or comply with these rules will result in ineligibility to participate in the program, as well as a possible fine or suspension. The decision of the NRBC Board of Directors will be final.

The National Reining Breeders Classic is a Texas non-profit corporation. All enrollment fees will be maintained at Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) Banks and all interest earned from the foal enrollments will be added money at the Breeders Classic.

National Reining Breeders Classic Program Terms & Conditions

STALLION ENROLLMENT – Stallions enrolling for the first time will pay an initial fee of \$2,500 divided as follows: \$1,250 for the Prepaid Pass Out Fee and \$1,250 for the current enrollment year.

For stallions renewing their enrollment, the fee is \$1,250. Stallion renewals must be postmarked no later than February 1 or there will be a \$1,000 late charge.

The annual stallion fee is allocated in the following way: 70% is purse money for the current year's show and 30% is administrative expense (advertising, promotional materials, office staff, postage, etc.).

In the event of death, being sold or the stallion owner electing to no longer participate in the program, the stallion's Prepaid Pass Out Fee will be drawn on to insure the eligibility of foals of the stallion's last breeding year. The stallion will also be listed as "Passed Out" in all advertising stallion listings.

The owner/agent or nominator of the stallion agrees to provide NRBC promotional information to each mare owner breeding to the stallion. He or she also agrees to mail NRBC Foal Enrollment Forms to the owner of each live foal at the time the Breeders Certificate is provided. The promotional material and forms are provided by the NRBC and may also be found on the NRBC Web Site www.nrbc.com.

FOAL ENROLLMENT — To be eligible for the 4-, 5- and 6-year-old National Reining Breeders Classic, the foal must be sired by a currently subscribed NRBC stallion. Owner/agent must complete the enrollment form (attach a copy of the registration papers, if available at this time), enclose a **one time payment for \$200 per foal**, postmarked by September 15, of their **birth year**, or \$250 if postmarked by December 31, of their birth year. Enrollment forms missing any pertinent information will be held. The owner/agent will be notified by phone, fax, or by mail to complete the enrollment process.

Late enrollment of foals is as follows:

\$2,500 - yearlings

\$7,500 - 2-year-olds

\$10,000 - 3-year-olds and older
